He gave it to us before man was ever created

"Let us make man in our image, after our likeness, and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth."

"So God created man in His own image, in the image of God, he created him; male and female He created them." (Gen.1:26-27)

Therefore God answers the question by saying that man is his creation. Thus God settles the question of man's origin, man's nature and man's destiny.

God also gives further answer in the words of Jesus Christ, "For what shall it profit a man if he shall gain the whole world and lose his own soul? Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?" (Mark8:36-37)

BUT what do others say about this man?

So in conclusion I ask this question, "Who is man?"

In quoting this text. Hebrews 2:6-9 points out that though humans are presently "lower" than the angels, they will ultimately be crown with "glory" and honor through the finished work of Christ Jesus on our behalf. CHRIST JESUS IS THE ARCHGOS, the "AUTHOR" OR "LEADER" OF OUR SALVATION WHICH HE SECURED BY HIS SUFFERING FOR OUR SIN.

In this way, the author of Hebrews answers the question: If Christ Jesus became man and experienced death, how could he be superior to the angels? Part on the answer is that he will judge angels, and so shall we (1Cor.6:3) because we will be elevated by Christ Jesus to a position higher than the angels.

My brothers and sisters with these words God designated man as the greatest love, and as the receiver of his forgivingness for sin. He also affirms that his love survives and overcomes death and that he stands to welcome man to his eternal home.

He also gave another answer when John was inspired to pen the greatest sentence ever penned: "For God so loved the world that he gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believeth in him should not perish but have everlasting life. (Jn.3:16)
